





























With tree pollen covering everything, and more skin showing everywhere you look, sometimes spring feels a bit like..., 2024, wooden planks, variable dimensions






































Elegia, 2024, Inkjet Print on Japanese Paper in artist's frame, 85 x 63 cm, Edition of 3 + 2 artist's proofs


































